ON FOURTH OF JULY WEEKEND, THE MOORINGS BEGINS OPERATIONS IN TORTOLA, BRITISH VIRGIN ISLANDS. WITH SIX 35-FOOT PEARSON YACHTS, CHARLIE AND GINNY CARY PIONEER YACHT CHARTERING IN THE BVI.

Along with his wife Ginny, Charlie moved from New Orleans to the British Virgin Islands to start a small boat rental operation called The Moorings, offering travelers a new and unique way to explore the islands and experience the thrill of sailing. The Carys worked tirelessly to make this new concept a success, caring for each customer like family.

Soon enough, The Moorings started to grow. Charlie and Ginny expanded their fleet and hired staff from the local community to help carry the company into the future. The Moorings expands into the lower Caribbean with a base in Marigot Bay, St. Lucia. **1981** The company begins its expansion into the Mediterranean with charter offerings in Greece.

A partnership is formed with catamaran yacht builders Robertson & Caine. The first catamarans are added to the fleet – the Moorings 4500 and the Moorings 3800. The Moorings 4500 is named "Best Charter Boat" by Cruising World Magazine. **1997**

The Moorings launches its first Power charters aboard a new 464 Powercat in the British Virgin Islands. **2001** The Moorings expands further into the Mediterranean and Exotics with destinations in the Grenadines; Lefkas, Greece; and the Seychelles. The company's largest yacht to date – the new Moorings 6200 luxury Crewed catamaran arrives in Tortola, BVI.

The Moorings completes a \$15 million expansion with the grand re-opening of the BVI flagship charter base, and the company's Clearwater, Florida headquarters moves into a new LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) certified building.

2008

The Moorings new flagship 4800 Catamaran is introduced for bareboat charters and is named "Boat of the Year" by Cruising World Magazine. The Moorings opens a new charter location in Miami, Florida.

2010

The Moorings debuts the 433 Power catamaran in the BVI and the Bahamas. The Moorings 5800 arrives in St. Lucia and Grenada. The Moorings 4000 Sail catamaran debuts in the BVI and St. Martin.



MOORINGS 48.4 MONOHULL

Coming to St. Martin, St. Lucia, Grenada and the British Virgin Islands, the Beneteau-built Moorings 48.4 designed by Berret-Racoupeau is an ultra-spacious sailboat featuring four en-suite cabins and room for up to ten guests. Inside, large portholes illuminate the 48.4's air-conditioned interior, accessed with ease from an expanded and gently sloping companionway. Light taupe cushioning compliments the contemporary oak finishing, making for an elegant ambiance both inside and out.

Outside, the 48.4 features a convertible transom that drops down to become a convenient swim platform. The mainsail arch and centered mast allow for increased comfort and stability from her dual helms. With all lines leading aft to the cockpit, a state-of-the-art Raymarine Navigation system, bow thruster and 75hp Yanmar diesel engine, the 48.4 is an intelligently designed platform and great for yacht charterers.

The Moorings' entire fleet of power catamarans in the British Virgin Islands are now registered fishing vessels, thus allowing guests to fish during their charter. The decision to register the yachts follows a reinforced fishing policy announced in the British Virgin Islands. The recent regulation enforcement imposed by the BVI government requires all vessels to have an official registration number in order to engage in any fishing activity without legal ramifications.

As of July 1st of this year, all Moorings Power Catamarans, ranging in size from 39 to 51 feet, have been assigned a government-issued fishing registration number. This is in addition to the entire fleet of Moorings all-inclusive Crewed yachts, previously registered. Guests aboard any Moorings Power or Crewed yacht in the British Virgin Islands are now welcome to fish during their charter vacation after obtaining a fishing license.



Online BVI Chart Briefings

The Moorings has just released a new online service for charter guests. Effective immediately, British Virgin Islands charter guests will have the option of viewing the destination Chart Briefing for their upcoming charter prior to departing on vacation.

The new online Chart Briefing will allow guests time to review the information at their leisure and get comfortable with what to expect when they arrive.
